

- VNC enables you to remotely access and control your devices wherever you are in the world, whenever you need.












# Real VNC® Viewer (Laptop or Mobile Device)

- Internet Protocol set to *Obtain an IP address automatically*







# Real VNC® Viewer (Laptop or Mobile Device)

- Internet Protocol set to *Use the following IP address*
  - **IP Address:** 192.168.1.250
  - **Subnet mask:** 255.255.255.0






To “Chat” with the user at the QL3-FS system, select the *Start Chat Session* talk bubble from the Real VNC® task bar (top center).


**NOTE:** The LAPTOP desktop is shown in RED behind the QL3-FS system connection window.

- Type a message and click “send”.
- Message will appear on the QL3-FS system.



- Locate and click on the Real VNC® Windows task bar Icon on the QL3-FS system.
- Click the “more” button to access the “Chat” option

- Type a message and click “send”.
- Message will appear on the Laptop.



- To move files from the QL3 system to the Laptop, select the *File Transfer* option.
- Navigate the QL System explorer window and locate the files to be transfers (i.e. TAG or data files).

- Highlight the files and then “Open”.
- This will transfer the files to the Laptop desktop.
